

## 2018 MISA Roster Card Text/Policies

### **Game Time, Ball Size, Number of Players on Field (By Age Group):**

5<sup>th</sup>&6<sup>th</sup> Grade: Two Each, 30 Minute Halves; Size Four Ball; 9v9 (Includes Goalie)

7<sup>th</sup>&8<sup>th</sup> Grade: Two Each, 35 Minute Halves; Size Five Ball; 11v11 (Includes Goalie)

9<sup>th</sup>&10<sup>th</sup> Grade: Two Each, 40 Minute Halves; Size Five Ball; 11v11 (Includes Goalie)

11<sup>th</sup>&12<sup>th</sup> Grade: Two Each, 40 Minute Halves; Size Five Ball; 11v11 (Includes Goalie)

All Grade Levels: 10 Minute Halftime Time

Extra Time, Additional Periods of Play, Penalty Kick Shoot Out; Only During MISA Playoffs, Based on FIFA Laws of game

### **Intentional Heading, or Directing of Ball with Head:**

5<sup>th</sup>&6<sup>th</sup> Grade: Intentional Heading, or Directing of Ball with Head Not Allowed

7<sup>th</sup>&8<sup>th</sup>+HS Grade: Intentional Heading, or Directing of Ball with Head Is Allowed

### **Playing Time, MISA Substitution Rule:**

All players must participate in at least 50% of the game, unless injured

All substitutions are at the discretion of the referee

Substitutions may occur: On either team's throw in; Goal-kicks by either team; After either team scores; Injury Stoppage; At halftime; When a player is shown a yellow card, that player may be substituted for, unless this is a second yellow resulting in a player ejection (red card).

### **Blow Out Policy:**

MISA shall enforce its blowout policy rule (see: [www.misasoccer.org](http://www.misasoccer.org)), when a team wins by more than (6) goals, regardless of reasoning.

### **Forfeit Policy:**

MISA shall enforce its forfeit policy rule (see: [www.misasoccer.org](http://www.misasoccer.org)), and may impose penalties for teams or clubs that have teams that violate the forfeit policy.

### **MISA Roster Card Policy:**

All MISA teams must present the approved MISA roster card, with all applicable fields completed, at all MISA games.

All MISA roster cards must be signed by the club's registrar.

All MISA roster cards must be laminated.

In the event that a team does not have a MISA roster card prior to kickoff, the game will be played, with both coaches notifying the MISA club administrator, Kellis Johnson of the issue following the game. The team without a roster card will forfeit the played game, losing 3-0.

Only players and coaches listed on the roster card can participate in the respective game.

A MISA Alliance Club, at their discretion, may approve a temporary or fill-in coach on a per game basis. The respective club's registrar must prepare a written note stating that the coach is authorized, and can be presented in an email form at check in.

The signature on this roster card verifies that all players and coaches, listed on this roster card are registered, insured, and authorized play in the age group included on this roster card. The club's signer (club registrar) is authorized to do so by their respective club, and the club accepts any and all liability for players and coaches participating in the Marin Interleague Soccer Alliance.
